## Rules for "Todd's Qualifiers"

**JUNIOR** (Class 11 above) Open to any pony / horse of any height who HAS NOT WON A TOTAL OF £50 under BSJA rules, ridden by any rider 16 years and under on 1<sup>st</sup> Jan. 2007. Jumps not to exceed 75 cm.

**SENIOR** (Class 15 above) Open to any pony / horse of any height who HAS NOT WON A TOTAL OF £75 under BSJA rules, ridden by any rider 17 years and over on 1<sup>st</sup> Jan. 2007. Jumps not to exceed 85 cm.

N.B. Any horse or pony which has won a Todd's final in previous years may NOT qualify for the final again, although they may continue to jump in the earlier Todd's classes if the rider wishes.

CLASS 19 Riders 6 yrs and under. - lead rein - not eligible for Class 19

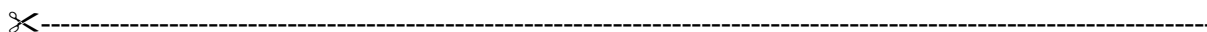
CLASS 20 Junior Riders 10 yrs and under

CLASS 21 Senior Riders 11 yrs and over.

If numbers permit, we will also have a GAMES CLASS for ADULTS (21yrs and over)

- All competitions will be run under Pony Club rules
- The committee reserves the right to amalgamate or subdivide classes according to the entry numbers.
- **New Members.**  
Trophies will be awarded to the highest placed new members in EQUITATION and in SHOW JUMPING.  
If there is a tie:  
    in EQUITATION – the judge’s decision is final.  
    in SHOW JUMPING – the trophy will be awarded to the new member with the fastest time.
- PC competitors must obtain written permission from their D.C. before the use of **spurs** will be permitted.  
**Only blunt spurs without rowels or sharp edges may be worn. If the spurs are curved, the curve must be downwards and the shank must point straight to the back and not exceed 3 cm in length.**
- *Legal Liability. Neither The Pony Club, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any responsibility for loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to any horse, rider, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.*
